To get the most out of your Equipment Inventory List, perform regular inventory checks to monitor condition, repairs, etc. Equipment Inventory Lists should be updated as soon as information has changed. For instance, once a vehicle has been serviced, a new accessory is purchased, warranty has been voided, etc.
